OLD BUSINESS

- 1. YOUTH SHOOT:** The Youth Shoot, conducted this year on October 4th, continues to be a growing success. Jim Edgington was the Match Director and was assisted by numerous club members, the Alabama Department of Wildlife and Fisheries, and Alabama Hunter Safety from Ft Rucker. There was archery, skeet, high power rifle and .22 cal shooting throughout the morning. Thanks for everyone's commitment in providing a valuable opportunity to teach our young people the joys of shooting sports.
- 2. FRIENDS OF NRA BANQUET:** The FNRA banquet was held on 25 September and was a huge success. Thanks to everyone who attended and your continued support for both the NRA and the club. This event is our chance to bolster all of the great NRA programs and shows our support and backing for their efforts. That support also pays off directly in the form of grant money each year.
- 3. NRA Grant Money.** We have received the Friends of NRA Grant in the amount of \$4,272.00. Jim Swift and Brent Underwood are working with Greg Swim to purchase the youth rifle, skeet machines. The machines (another wobble thrower similar to our current one and a rabbit/teal machine) should be delivered to the range by late October. Greg will let us know when they are operational.
- 4. Land acquisition:** The land acquisition is on hold at the moment.
- 5. November 1, 2008 is the Women on Target.** This is an NRA sponsored event to encourage women to get more involved with shooting activities. This looks to be the only event of its type in the area. Please spread the word to all the women you know. This is a great event to help get women more informed about guns and guns safety.

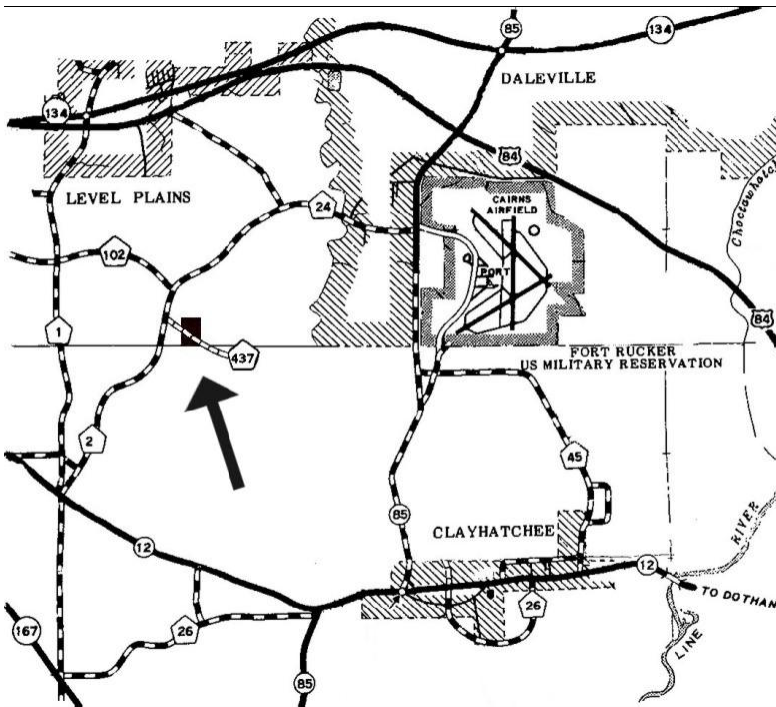
SPECIALTY MATCH GRAND TOTAL AND WINNERS
